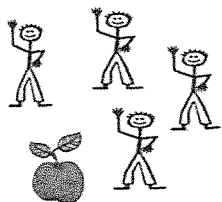


EQUITY (and EQUALITY)

1b) How would you share one apple amongst 4 people equitably?



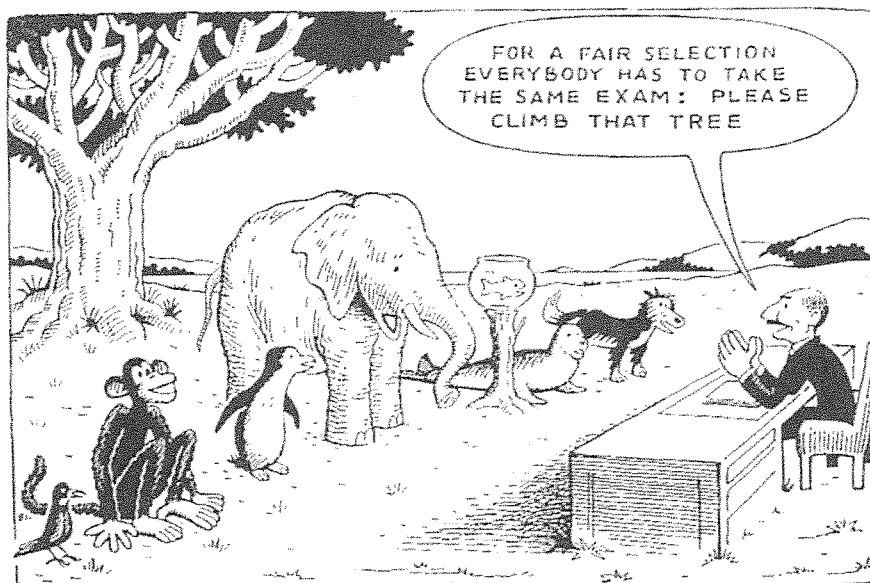
2a) Mindmap the similarities and differences between 'equity' and 'equality', using the words below (use the back of your sheet).
